 - d) The images that Rachel took belonged to what person? (Her father, Laban, vs. 19)
 - e) What did Jacob say could be done to the person who had stolen Laban’s images? (Jacob said the person should not live, vs. 32)
 - f) How many years did Jacob say that he was with Laban? (20 years, vs. 38)

 - f) What was Jacob’s name changed to? (Israel, vs. 28)
 - g) What did Jacob call the place of his encounter with God? (Peniel or the Face of God, vs. 30)
 - h) How was Jacob physically affected after his wrestling encounter? (He limped, vs. 31)

- a) Who did Jacob put at the back of the pack when approaching Esau? (Rachel and Joseph, vs. 2)
- b) What did Esau do when he met with Jacob? (He ran to meet him, embraced him, kissed him and wept, vs. 4)
- c) Did Esau want the gift from Jacob? Did he finally take it? (No, Esau said he had enough, vs. 9; Yes, Jacob urged him and he finally took it, vs. 11)
- d) Did Jacob come to the land of Canaan? (Yes, vs. 18)
- e) What did Jacob call the altar he made? (EleloheIsrael, vs. 20)

2) Matthew 11 – Read & Word Study/Research

- a) What evidence did Jesus reference as proof to John that He (Christ) was the Messiah? (Jesus referenced things seen and heard such as: Blind receiving sight, lame walking again, lepers being cleansed, deaf hearing, dead being raised from the dead and the poor having the gospel preached to them, vs. 4-5)
- b) What Old Testament prophecy is referenced in Matthew 11:10? (Malachi 3:1)
- c) As great as John the Baptizer was, who did Jesus reference as being greater? (The least in the kingdom of heaven, vs. 11)

- a) What is Leah’s daughter’s name? (Dinah, vs. 1)
- b) Genesis 34:2 says that Shechem defiled Dinah by committing sexual sin before marriage. Genesis 34:7 says he had wrought _____ in Israel in lying with Jacob’s daughter; which thing _____ to be done. (folly; ought not)
- c) What did the sons of Jacob ask Shechem and Hamor along with all their males, to do? (To be circumcised, vs. 15-17)

- d) Who were the two sons of Jacob that were involved in the slaughter of all the males? (Simeon and Levi, vs. 25)
- e) Was Jacob excited about the consequences of Simeon's and Levi's actions? Why not? (No; Jacob feared the Canaanites would gather themselves and destroy he and his house, vs. 30)

- d) What is the location of Bethel also referred to as? (Luz, vs. 6)
- e) In what verses does God repeat the promises to Jacob? (Verses 11-12)
- f) What was the name of Rachel's son that she gave birth to? (Benjamin, vs. 18)
- g) What happened during Rachel's child birth? (Rachel died, vs. 18-19)
- h) At what age did Isaac die? (180 years, vs. 28)
- i) Who buried Isaac? (Esau and Jacob, vs. 29)

- d) On the other hand, Jesus said the Pharisees had “condemned the _____” in Matthew 12:7 as it references His disciples. (guiltless)
- e) In Matthew 12:12 and in line with proper Old Testament teaching, Jesus clearly stated that it was “_____ to do well on the Sabbath days.” (lawful)
